

Reading Books

Children are encouraged to read their book **at least 3 times a week**, complete an Accelerated reader quiz based on it and then change their book if they received a score of 80% or higher. Book reviews need to be completed if the score is below 80% before changing their book. Children need to also bring in their Reading Planner every Monday for checking.

Homework

Children will receive a piece of Maths or English homework on a **Friday** via Dojo which should be completed in their homework book or uploaded to Dojo by the following **Friday**. Children learn specific spelling patterns in class, but please continue to practice the y3/4 spelling lists in your individual Reading Planners.

Remember the homework challenge menu that is ongoing throughout the half term also!

PE

Children can come to school in their PE kits for their PE day. Our PE day for this half term will be on a **Monday**. Our PE unit will be centred around **Basketball**.

Year 4: term 2.1

English

We will be continuing to look at **Non-Chronological reports** and finish the story '**The boy at the back of the classroom**.'

We will create class work, group work and independent work based on these.

We will also look at **fiction** texts such as **Vajak Paw** before the half term and continue this after the half term

Maths

*We are using the Maths mastery resources of **White Rose Maths** and additional resources from **Maths No Problem**.*

*We will continue to learn about the principles behind **multiplication** and **division** confidently, linking with the concept of **length and perimeter**. We expect to begin a unit on **fractions** which will continue after the half term too.*

RE

The unit explores the act of worship in the teachings of **Buddhism** and we look at what is important in their everyday life.

Latin

We will be using the scheme **Minimus** again.

The next unit is '**Work, work, work**' looking at verbs and verb endings with some songs and cartoons along the way to help us learn it more easily.

Computing

Children will spend 5 mins every IT session to practice Maths x table skills. We will also use the computers for **Data Logging** this half term.

Music

Some children will continue with their instrument tuition whilst the rest of the class continue with **Charanga** and composing songs and rhythms.

PE

The children will need their full school PE kits on **Monday** when we will be doing **Basketball** (Please remember no earrings or football shirts).

PSHE

We are using a scheme called '**Jigsaw**' which helps encourage mindfulness.

This half term's unit is '**Dreams and Goals**'

We will also work towards achieving our **EAAA** badge.
